Peter always helps his mother.

- Who** always helps his mother? – **Peter**. (don't use any auxiliary if you ask about **the subject** - *who* is the doer of the action.)
- Who does** Peter always help? – Peter always helps his **mother**. (use the table below to ask about **the object**).
