

## ***Choose a job and write a dialogue between an employer and the future employee.***

<p><b>Step 1:</b> Greetings (good morning, good afternoon, hello...) Say where you found the ad and ask if the person is still needing an employee. Then justify your interest in the job.</p> <p><b>Step 2:</b> Ask when the employer needs you and say when you'll be available.</p> <p><b>Step 3:</b> Ask him/her <u>how often</u> he will need you.</p> <p><b>Step 4:</b> Ask him <u>how long</u> he/she'll need you.</p> <p><b>Step 5:</b> Answer questions about your experience, skills, and qualities.</p> <p><b>Step 6:</b> Ask how much you will be paid and suggest any other activities you could do. Explain why they should hire you!</p> <p><b>Step 7:</b> Thank your future employer and say you accept the appointment.</p>	<p><b>Step 1:</b> Greetings + Say you're still interested in looking for someone.</p> <p><b>Step 2:</b> Give as many details as possible about the periods of time you will need the employee (at weekends, on Saturdays...)</p> <p><b>Step 3:</b> Say how often you will need him (once, twice, three times a week / from...to...) and detail the different tasks you're expecting him/her to do.</p> <p><b>Step 4:</b> Say how much time he/she will spend doing the job. Say how long you will need the person. Give any useful information about the job.</p> <p><b>Step 5:</b> Ask about the person's experience, skills, and qualities.</p> <p><b>Step 6:</b> Offer a wage for the job and ask if it is reasonable for the person.</p> <p><b>Step 7:</b> Thank the applicant for all the information and suggest a date and a place for a second appointment if you wish.</p>
